**Health Attestation**

I hereby certify that the meat products:

- a. were processed in abattoirs /processing plants operating in accordance with New Zealand law and approved for export.
- b. were derived from animals of New Zealand origin and that New Zealand is free from Anthrax, bluetongue disease, bovine spongiform encephalopathy (BSE), Brucella abortus, Brucella melitensis, Coxiella burnetii, foot and mouth disease, lumpy skin disease, maedi-visna, Nairobi sheep disease, ovine chlamydiosis, peste des petits ruminants, Rift Valley fever, rinderpest, scrapie, sheep and goat pox, and vesicular stomatitis.
- c. were derived from animals which have passed ante-mortem and post-mortem inspection at the time of slaughter and that the supplying establishments were determined to be free of Tuberculosis, Ovine epididymitis, Caprine Arthritis Encephalitis, Border's disease, Blackleg, and Leptospirosis for two years in accordance with the notified assurance system.
- d. come from animals slaughtered at abattoir /processing plant where no bovine, porcine and poultry tissue or protein is added to the products at any stage.
- e. were packed in fresh packaging material that complies with New Zealand sanitary requirements and were subjected to precautions to prevent contamination prior to dispatch from the abattoir /processing plant.
- f. do not have residues of pesticides, drugs, mycotoxins and chemicals above the Maximum Residue Limits prescribed internationally.
- g. come from animals that have never been fed with feeds produced from internal organs, blood meal and tissues of ruminant origin.
