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The meat comes from animals slaughtered at establishments registered for export under the Export Control Act 1982. The animals from which the product has been produced were born and raised in Australia. No animal tissues/protein of another species has been added to the meat at any stage. The meat does not contain residues of pesticides, drugs, mycotoxins and chemicals above the maximum residue limits prescribed internationally. Australia is free from scrapie and is recognized by the OIE as negligible risk for bovine spongiform encephalopathy. Australia is free from foot and mouth disease (Type C, SAT 1, 2, 3), swine vesicular disease, Aujeszky disease, African swine fever, vesicular stomatitis, Rift Valley fever, rinderpest and lumpy skin disease. If the product is derived from sheep or goats, the source animals were kept on properties that were free from the following diseases for the last 2 years: Nairobi sheep disease, Border's disease, tuberculosis, sheep and goat pox, blue tongue, peste des petits ruminants, ovine epididymitis, caprine and ovine brucellosis (*Brucella melitensis*), anthrax, tetlock, leptospirosis, contagious agalactia, caprine arthritis/encephalitis, maedi-visna and ovine chlamydiosis. If the product is derived from pigs, the source animals were kept on properties that were free from the following diseases for the last 2 years: enterovirus encephalomyelitis (Taflan disease), transmissible gastro-enteritis, porcine reproductive/respiratory syndrome, trichinellosis, tuberculosis, porcine brucellosis, anthrax, atrophic rhinitis and leptospirosis. The source animals were not fed with feeds produced from internal organs, blood meal or tissues of ruminant origin. Fresh packing materials were used and product handling satisfied the necessary sanitary and hygienic requirements.
